
Someone dies of pancreatic cancer nearly **every 2 hours** in Australia today



Pancreatic cancer is the **3rd most common cancer-causing death**




Pancreatic cancer claims more lives than...



By 2030, it's predicted to be **our 2nd deadliest cancer****

5-year survival rates for comparative cancers in Australia



Darker shades = Survival rate from 1991-1995
Lighter shades = Survival rate from 2016-2020



Pancreatic cancer continues to have a significantly lower five-year survival rate, while survival rates for other cancers have improved substantially over time due to sustained investment in research

Approximately **4,039 people** are expected to die from pancreatic cancer in 2025




Approximately **4,825 people** are expected to be diagnosed with pancreatic cancer in 2025[>]
